

2021 Scholarship Guidelines

Who is eligible?

- ❖ Any student whose primary residence is in Olmsted County.
- ❖ Those planning to attend or are currently enrolled in an accredited college or vocational technical institute.
- ❖ Those majoring in agriculture or a related field.

Scholarship Amount: Four \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

- ❖ Two scholarships will be awarded to current high school seniors (Freshman '22- '23)
- ❖ Two scholarships will be awarded to college level sophomore's ('22-'23 School Year)

Scholarship Criteria:

- ❖ Based on leadership and agricultural interest.
- ❖ Preference will be given to applicants who are Farm Bureau members or applicants under their immediate family's membership.
- ❖ Typed statement, up to three pages, describing the applicant's interest in agriculture or related field. In addition, the applicants past, current, and desired future involvement in agriculture or related field.
- ❖ Scholarships will be awarded following receipt of semester or year-end transcripts. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA or greater. Once a transcript is received, funds will be sent directly to the recipient.
